

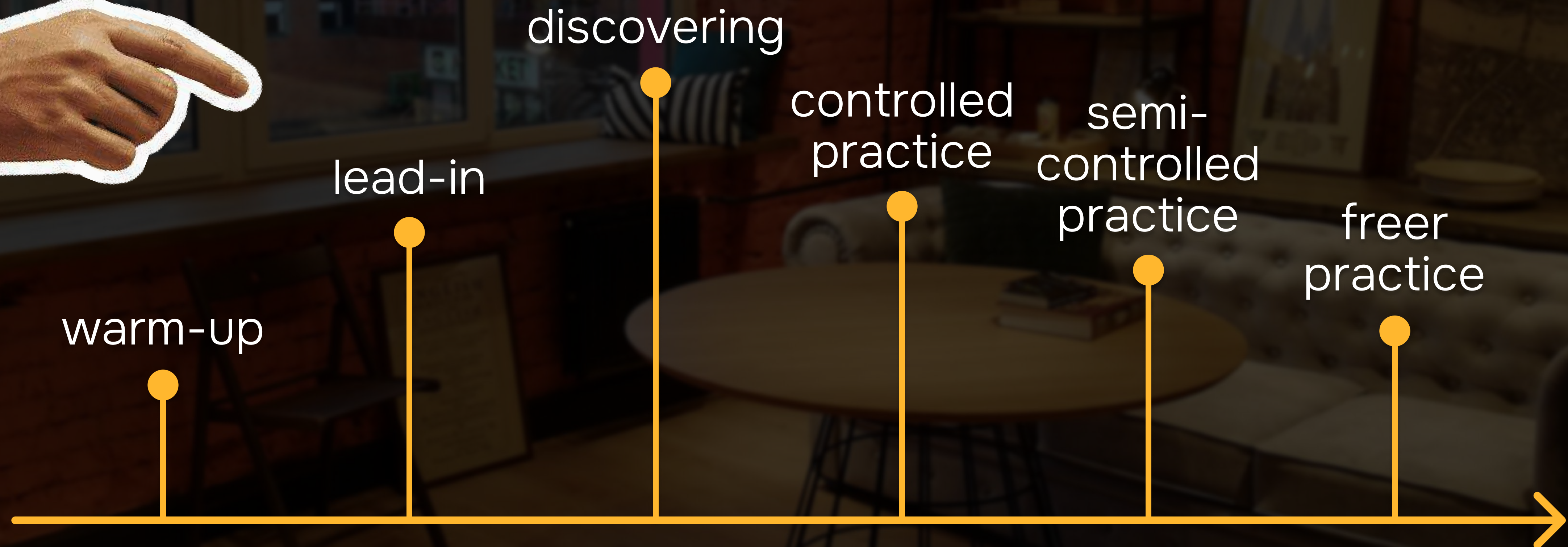

What shapes our personality?

Family

Language

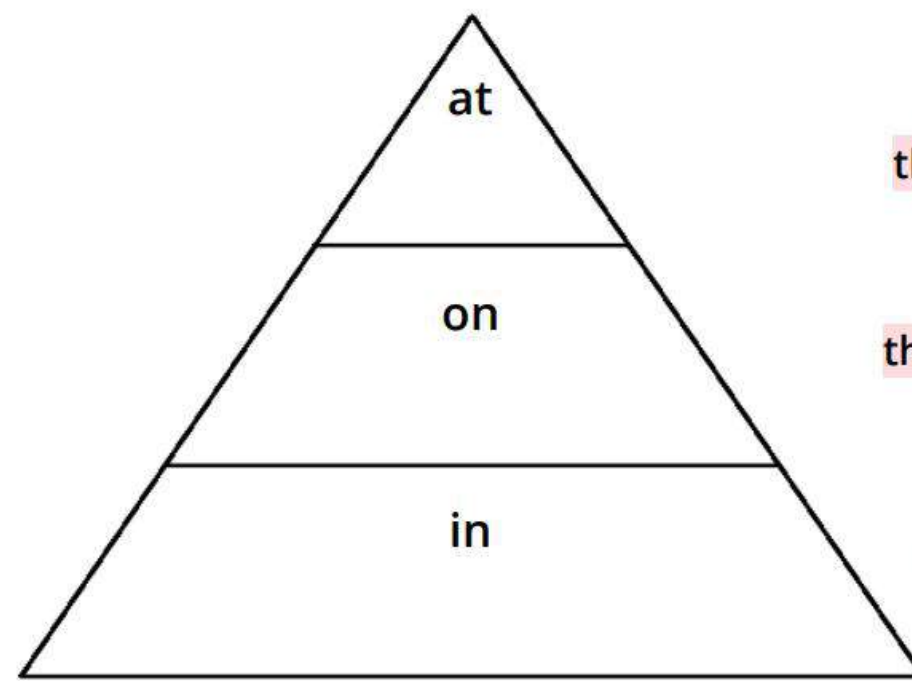
